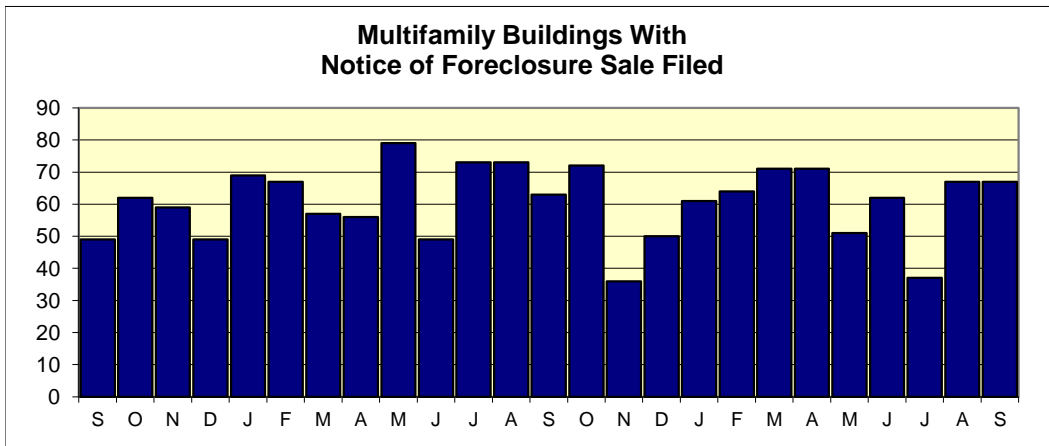
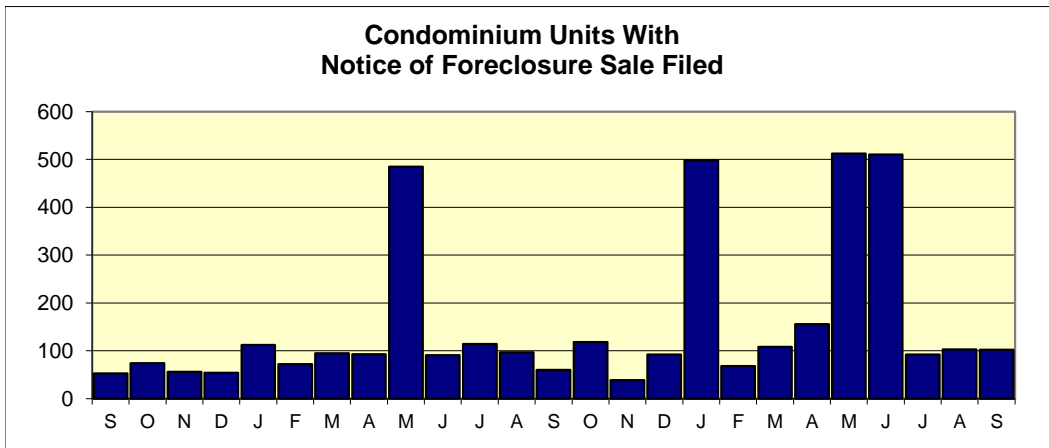
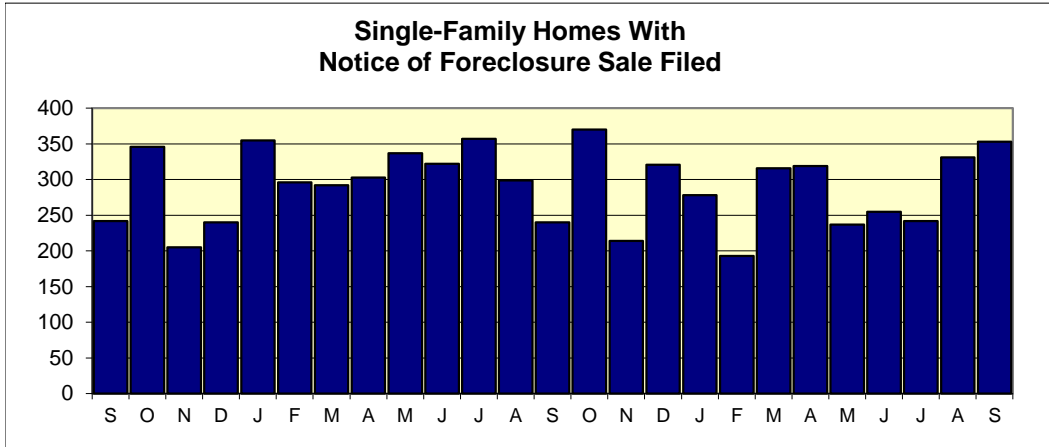

A Notice of Foreclosure Sale is filed when a lender is **starting** a foreclosure process against a homeowner.

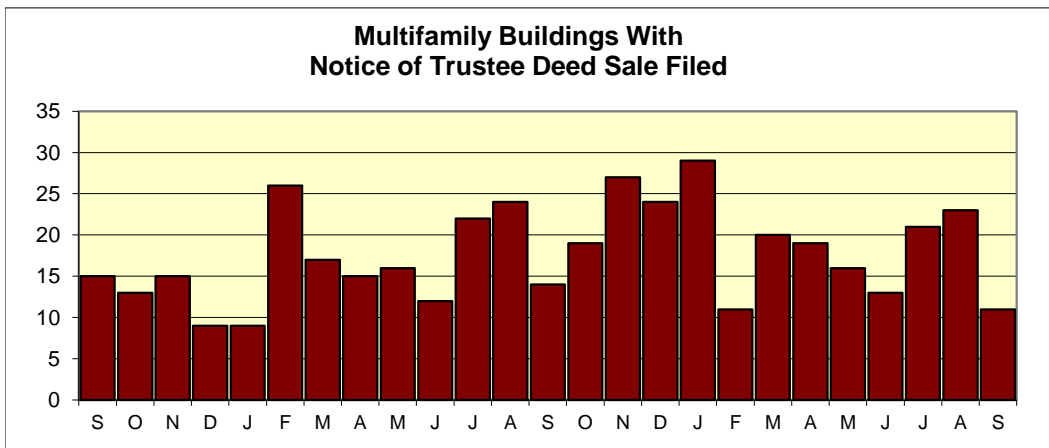
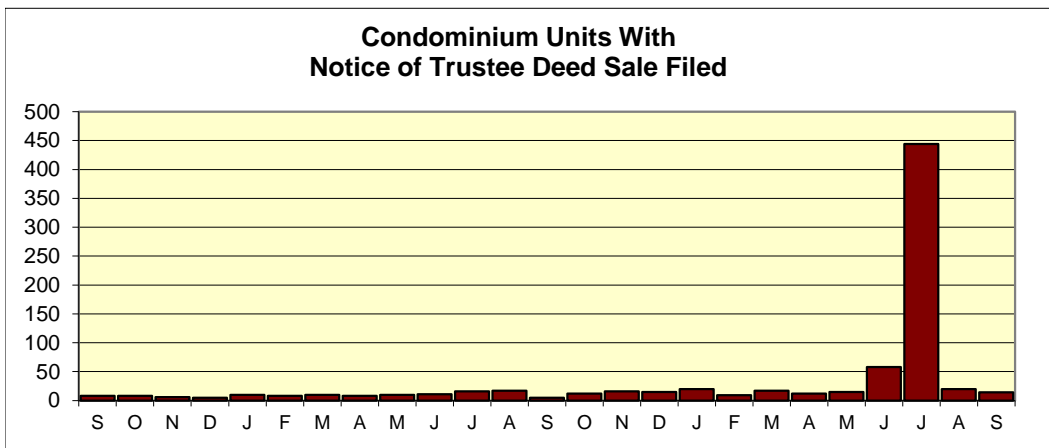
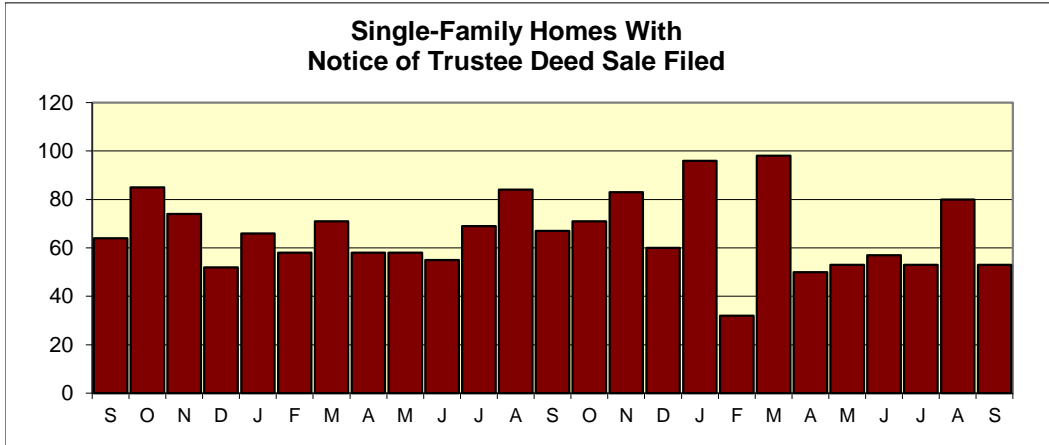
